

CPP Equipping Seminars

Fifteen times in the New Testament the phrase “*keep on the alert*” is used by Jesus, Paul & Peter. The word “**alert**” has a very precise meaning in the Greek;

G1127 γρηγορεύω *gray-gor-yoo'-o*

From G1453; to *keep awake*, that is, *watch* (literally or figuratively): - be vigilant, wake, (be) watch (-ful).

The express goal of CPP Ministries, and the **CPP Equipping Seminar**, is to be a tool to assist Christians in doing this very thing. In all of my travels around the world where I have had the honor to fellowship with the persecuted church, one thing has become very clear.....the churches in countries that are free from Christian Persecution (*for now anyway*) are the least prepared to **stand** boldly for their faith in Jesus Christ. We want to help equip the body of Christ so that they too will hear the words from Jesus “**well done, good and faithful servant**” on “**that day**”(note; the phrase “*that day*” is used 93 times in the NT).

The **CPP Equipping Seminar** consists of **6** – one hour sessions usually done on a Saturday. These sessions include;

- **WHY WE PREPARE**
- **TO STAND OR NOT TO STAND (Part 1)**
- **TO STAND OR NOT TO STAND (Part 2)**
- **THE VALUE IN SUFFERING (Sacrifice of Christian Hedonism)**
- **OBSERVE & PATTERN (Based on Philippians 3 :17 & 10)**
- **IN THE FUTURE (Based on 2 Timothy 4:5-8)**

At the seminar there will be books available for purchase that will help equip the saints to “**Stand Firm**”, a library set is also given to the host church. A Sunday school quarterly is being developed for further education after the seminar. There is no set charge for the seminar but a love offering will be taken to cover travel and materials expenses. On the next page are some testimonies from saints who have been through one of our seminars.
